TASTING NOTES

Alwyn is Ngatarawa's finest Chardonnay. A full-bodied, elegant, complex and textured Chardonnay in a contemporary style.

Our ripest Chardonnay was selected to make this wine, its low yield and consistent ripeness giving exceptional concentration. Barrel fermented and matured on lees in the same French oak barriques, this wine shows excellent integration and complexity that will only improve with time.

Pale straw

Bouquet

Ripe peach and grapefruit with perfumed oak, cinnamon and nutmeg.

Palate

Full bodied and concentrated. Persistent stone fruit and citrus flavours supported by spicy oak.

Cellaring

This wine may be enjoyed for up to 5 years from vintage date.
