TASTING NOTES

Silks Pinot Noir 2004 is a contemporary wine style that shows excellent ripe fruit and supple texture.

A fruit driven Pinot Noir made from ripe grapes specially chosen for their concentrated flavours. In the vineyard careful management of the canopy of the vines and crop thinning were employed to maximise ripe fruit flavours and texture in the finished wine. This wine has been enhanced by 12 months maturation in French oak.

Colour

Brilliant ruby.

Bouquet

Ripe cherries and sweet cedary oak.

Palate

Cherries, strawberries and plums. Medium-bodied with soft supple texture.

Cellaring

Can be enjoyed now or cellared for up to 5 years from vintage date.

Food Suggestion

May be enjoyed with contemporary red meat dishes – try duck, venison and lamb.
