TASTING NOTES

Silks Sauvignon Blanc 2005 is a contemporary wine style that shows vibrant fruit flavours typical of classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc.

A fruit driven Sauvignon Blanc made from ripe grapes specially chosen for their concentrated flavours. Fruit from four different vineyard blocks each contribute to the flavour spectrum and definition in this wine.

Colour

Straw with green tinges.

Bouquet

Intense ripe tropical fruit with a nettle edge.

Palate

Lively and full bodied. Ripe stonefruit and citrus.

Cellaring

This wine is best enjoyed while it is young and fresh.
